Pursuant to the State of California Public Resources Code Section 21000 *et seq.* and Section 15088 of the "Guidelines for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act," the City of Palo Alto as Lead Agency has prepared a Final Environmental Impact Report (Final EIR) for the Comprehensive Plan Update. The Final EIR includes responses to comments received regarding the February 2016 Draft EIR and the February 2017 Supplement to the Draft EIR. The Final EIR also includes a description of the preferred scenario proposed for adoption for the Comprehensive Plan Update and necessary clarifications and changes to the text of the Draft environmental documents.
